Why: To support YWCA's programs and services. Membership and program fees cover only 65% of the funds needed to operate YWCA Greenwich. Proceeds from the Live, Laugh, Love Gala help cover the 35% difference and also make it possible to provide subsidies and scholarships for those who cannot otherwise afford to take advantage of our programs and services.

This year YWCA Greenwich will provide free programs and services to our community for:

- Scholarships for children and youth in need and/or at risk who participate in preschool and afterschool programs, camps and aquatics.
- Crisis intervention services to victims of domestic violence, including two 24/7 hotlines, individual and group counseling, criminal and civil court services, safety planning and shelter. YWCA Greenwich has the largest number of programs for child victims in Fairfield County.
- Workshops and seminars that support and enrich the lives of women and girls with well-known speakers and educators.
- Community racial justice programs and women's empowerment initiatives.
