We are privileged to have an energetic and passionate Board of Directors, a devoted Leadership Council, a small staff that tries to do it better day after day...year after year...and a committed base of generous supporters. Childhood Education

YWCA Greenwich provided educational programs that afforded girls and boys ages 15 months to 14 years educational platforms on which to build their knowledge...as well as to grow their social, emotional and physical vitality. In addition, annual member surveys support our ongoing reputation for creative curriculums based on Connecticut State Benchmarks, staff excellence, scheduling flexibility, and facility safety and cleanliness.

Consistent with our core mission of *eliminating racism*, we very much encouraged diversity in our student population. Ending racism begins with the young...and the younger, the better. In the 2013-14 academic year, YWCA Greenwich Preschool was truly international. We taught children of many racial, ethnic and economic backgrounds from 17 countries, including Argentina, Brazil, Bulgaria, Chile, Denmark, England, Germany, India, Italy, Japan, Mexico, Netherlands, New Zealand, Poland, United States, Switzerland and Venezuela.

Children 15 months to 2 years enjoyed the *1-2-3 Grow Preschool Program*. The YWCA is one of the very few area preschools to provide learning for 1 year olds. 3s and 4s



enjoyed the *Tinker Tots* program that features instructional classes in gymnastics, music, Spanish and swimming. *Extended Day* and *Full Day* programs, popular with working parents, were also available.

More students than ever attended the *Kaleidoscope After-School Program* for girls and boys 5 to 11 from 2:30 to 6:00 pm daily during the public school academic year. It combines homework and study with 14 other activities, including field trips, and there is free pick up from many elementary schools. Both *Kaleidoscope Vacation Camp* and *Preschool Vacation Camp* served children when schools were closed for holidays.

Summers at YWCA Greenwich found our three camps going full bore, which meant that our four outdoor play areas – *Greenwich's only Water Park*, two *Kompan Structures Playgrounds* and the *Sand Play Area* – were well used. For 45 years, girls and boys 5 to 11 have loved two-session *Camp Ta-Yi-To* with the most diverse activities schedule in the region. Two-session *Preschool Summer Camp* was well attended. And our two-week *Girls Circle Camp* helped pre-teens build confidence and self-esteem.



YWCA Greenwich Preschool, After-School and Summer Camps are licensed by the Connecticut Department of Public Health and comply with all regulation standards for health and safety.



Health & Fitness

YWCA Greenwich has a myriad of activities that improved the health and fitness of girls and boys and women and men ages two through seniors.

Four popular *Group Exercise Classes* – Ballates, Body Barre, Group Rip and Kettle Bells – were added, bringing the total to 42 classes held each week. In addition, our *Fitness Center* featured a *Spin Studio*, a staff of certified *Personal Trainers* and a *Massage Therapist*...plus top-of-the-line weight circuits, bicycles, tread mills, ellipticals, adaptive motion trainers and more.

Key supporters of YWCA Greenwich provided funds for a new *Fitness Center* with cutting-edge equipment. Now members can enjoy new Precor Treadmills, AMTs and Ellipticals with 140-channel, high-definition picture quality and internet access monitors...plus new Espresso Bikes with interactive road racing programs...plus a Spin Room with new Star Trac Blade Ion 100 Bicycles with computer monitors...plus new



Precor Discovery strength equipment and five new locker rooms including a Women's Locker Room with sauna and a Men's Locker Room with steam. There is a staff of certified, experienced Personal Trainers and a Massage Room with licensed therapists.

Children ages 3 to 18 enjoyed modern dance, contemporary jazz, hip hop and ballet classes in the modern *Royce/Porter Dance and Yoga Studio*. Our large gymnasium was home to an age-specific *Soccer* program for girls and boys 2 to 5 years old...and *Gymnastic* classes for kids 3 to 15, beginner to advanced, were taught by the famed Greenwich High School Varsity Coach. *Badminton* gained in popularity.

Two new programs...*Private baseball pitching lessons* with former St. Louis Cardinals right hander, Mike Parisi...and *NOW Tennis*, for girls and boys 3 to 13 using age-appropriate sized racquets and balls, became instantly popular.





Aquatics

YWCA Greenwich offered girls and boys and adults, six months old to seniors, a complete and integrated Aquatics program in a 6-lane, warm water pool. There were group and private swim lessons...specialty classes including *Aqua Aerobics*, *Aqua Arthritis*, *Aqua Core*, *Water Polo*, *Scuba*, and *Kayaking*... plus *Lifeguard Training*, *CPR/AED* and *Water Safety Instructor* courses. Popular times were available throughout the week for both Family and Lap Swims. All instructors are American Red Cross certified.

The successful YWCA Greenwich Learn-to-Swim program improved technique, built endurance and was the training ground for the 225 member – girls and boys ages 5 to 18 years – *YWCA Dolphins Swim Team* that continued its 45-year winning tradition. The nationally ranked Dolphins won a pool full of medals in swim meets from Charlotte, North Carolina to Middletown, Connecticut to Irvine,

California. Led by 10-year-old Meghan Lynch, who set four national age group records in the 50 and 100 short and long course breast stroke...and Thomas Dillinger and Alex Lewis...the Dolphins set 20 individual state resident records and four relay records.

Training for Success Seminars were held for Dolphins Team members and their parents, featuring Olympic swimming medalists, health professionals and educators.

The YWCA Greenwich *Masters Swim Team* had a strong season.

On November 30, 2013, the *YWCA Greenwich Aquatic Hall of Fame Luncheon* was held at the Hyatt Regency Greenwich. This special event recognized outstanding swimmers, divers, water polo players, coaches and volunteers who have lived in Greenwich and given back to the community. Proceeds were used for YWCA aquatic scholarships.

Domestic Abuse Services

YWCA Greenwich, *the only licensed provider of domestic violence services in the community*, delivered a wide range of multi-lingual, free services to thousands of victims, including children. Your YWCA provides two 24/7 hotlines; emergency shelter; life-saving safety planning; crisis intervention; child and adult counseling; and victims services at Stamford Superior Court. One in every four women will experience domestic violence in her lifetime.

One in three young girls in the U.S. is a victim of physical, verbal or emotional violence. Horrific stories of anger, fear, lost hope... even death...are heard daily. Domestic violence shatters hearts, souls and lives. Yet many have been able to escape abusive relationships and build new lives with the help of YWCAs, the largest providers of domestic violence services in the country. A *Candlelight Vigil* in October – Domestic Violence Awareness Month – memorialized those victims whose lives were taken in Connecticut, and participants lit candles of hope for the future. Included in the month's activities was a presentation of *Amy's Story*, a documentary about a domestic violence



homicide that was shown at Greenwich's Bow Tie Cinema.

This year, 248 Greenwich men, the largest number ever, joined the *Father's Day Campaign Against Domestic Violence* by signing their names to a full-page advertisement in the *Greenwich Time*. Fourteen community leaders – including clergy and elected officials – committed as Co-Chairs of this important event.

YNet, a partnership between the YWCA and Greenwich High School, works to end teen dating violence and foster healthy relationships. Since its inception, over 500 students have been trained to educate peers and the greater community. The annual *Ultimate Frisbee Tournament* was held June 1, 2014 to raise funds for this outreach program.

The *Old Bags Luncheon*, the only event in Greenwich that exclusively benefits YWCA Domestic Abuse Services, took place May 7, 2014 at the Belle Haven Club. A sellout every year, it features live and silent auctions of new, vintage and gently used hand bags donated by designers, retailers and individuals.

YWCA Greenwich strongly supports *Empowering Women* as a core mission of the YWCA.

We spotlight and honor the successes of women in the community as industry, government, non-profit business leaders...as well as volunteers and mentors...at a series of special events and leadership seminars throughout the year.

There were a number of interesting seminars offered. Author Reshma Saujani discussed her book, *Women Who Don't Wait in Line*, a call for women to rise to the top ranks of corporations and governments. Phyllis Chesler, author of *An American Bride in Kabul*, described how her harrowing ordeal in a harem in Afghanistan shaped her into a modern feminist leader and life-long defender of human rights. A screening of the documentary, *The Bully Effect and Bystander*, attended by over 200, at the Greenwich Bow Tie Cinema, included a panel discussion

featuring Greenwich School Superintendent William McKersie and Marji Lipshez-Shapiro of the Anti-Defamation League. Partners in our seminar series included: Allstate Foundation, Breast Cancer Alliance, Greenwich Hospital, JCC Greenwich, Junior League of Greenwich, Stamford Hospital and the United Way of Greenwich.

YWCA Women's Leadership Special Events are among the most popular in the community. The 20th annual *Spirit of Greenwich Awards*, held in September, 2013 at Greenwich Country Club, honored ten exceptional women volunteers whose devotion and accomplishments have enriched the lives of many in our community. The 39th annual *BRAVA Awards*, held in February, 2014 recognized ten outstanding professional women...proven executives, role models and established leaders in their respective fields.

YWCA Greenwich strongly supports *Eliminating Racism* as a core mission of the YWCA. From 1915, when the YWCA held its first Interracial Conference in Kentucky...through its battle for civil rights legislation in 1965... to its continuing, active support of the Hate Crimes Act, YWCAs have been unwavering in their historic battle for racial justice. At YWCA Greenwich, we work constantly to join together people of all ages, races, cultures and backgrounds in a common goal of justice, freedom and dignity.

Annually, YWCA Greenwich offers racial justice initiatives that promote the attributes of diversity and direct attention to the patterns of hatred and bigotry that still may remain in the community and beyond.

Our *Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Celebration* in January, 2014...a free, community-wide event...featured the presentation of a *YWCA Racial Justice Scholarship* to senior *Treasure Pray of Greenwich High School*, who had

demonstrated special effort to encourage people to respect differences, to promote equality and to eliminate all forms of bigotry and bias. The keynote address was given by *Professor Jonathan Holloway, PhD and Chair, Yale University Department of African American Studies.*

Joined by 64 other community organizations – the most ever – including every public school, the 5th annual YWCA Greenwich *Stand Against Racism Day* took place on April 25, 2014. Our event at Greenwich Town Hall included talks by Greenwich High School students Isaiah Nins and Mirella Rojas, School Superintendent William McKersie and others. Music was provided by the First Baptist Church Choir. In her keynote address, YWCA President and CEO Adrienne Singer offered an insightful quotation, “Racism is man’s greatest threat to man...the maximum of hatred for the minimum of reason.”

The YWCA continued to host a monthly *Diversity Book Club* meeting.
